



Poster presentations

Each poster should have a maximum size of 120 cm tall x 90 cm wide. Fixating materials will be available on the spot. Posters will be displayed during the entire event in the exhibit area. Authors of the posters are responsible for the assembly and presentation. Presenters will be allowed to begin mounting their posters on their assigned board at 9:00 a.m. A staff member will be present in the Poster area and available to provide assistance and answer any questions. The Organizing Committee will attribute your poster a number and provide it to you prior to the meeting's first day. The poster should be mounted on its properly numbered spot. Presenters should attend their poster during all coffee break periods to discuss their work with scientists visiting their poster.

Poster Corner presentations

Posters selected for the Poster Corner should follow the same dimension guidelines as all other posters. Each poster corner presentation will be 5 minutes long (3 minutes presentation + 2 minutes Q&A) The Poster Corner location will be clearly identified. The Poster Corner session will have a unique time slot scheduled after Saturday's afternoon coffee break.

Oral presentations

Oral presentations will have 15 minutes in length (12 minutes + 3 minutes for Q&A). The electronic projection equipment provided will include a laptop equipped with Windows and PowerPoint. Please bring a backup of your Power Point presentation to the meeting on a USB pendrive. **There will NOT be any MAC equipment available.** If you are a Macintosh user, we highly recommend you to test your presentation on a Windows PC to verify it converts accurately. Authors should provide their presentation to the responsible staff member in the auditorium prior to their session start, never after the previous break.
